SYSTEM: Audi/Seat/Skoda/Volkswagen serial kit

TITLE: Idle adjustment using the Multi-Tester pro

ISSUE: On certain control units it is possible to electronically adjust the desired idle speed. The function is normally found under "10 Alter adaption values" channel 0001. In some cases it is necessary to first enter the login code. I have attached some examples of login codes.

ACTION:

Alternative 1

Select 01 Engine

Select Alter Adaptation

Select channel number 01

Change the specified speed in steps of 10 rpm with the arrow up and down buttons (actually changes the adaption values).

Alternative 2 (login code necessary)

Select 01 Engine

Select Login

Enter login code

Select Alter Adaptation

Select channel number 01

Change the specified speed in steps of 10 rpm with the arrow up and down buttons (actually changes the adaption values).

NOTES: Conditions for adjustment is no DTC's stored in memory and engine temperature must be 85°C minimum.
